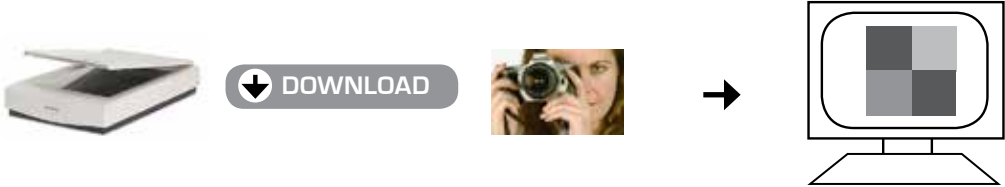


Determining Adequate Info

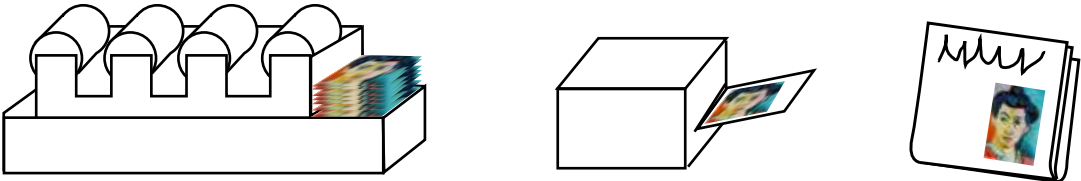
You need to gather enough information _____ *it is initially captured.*



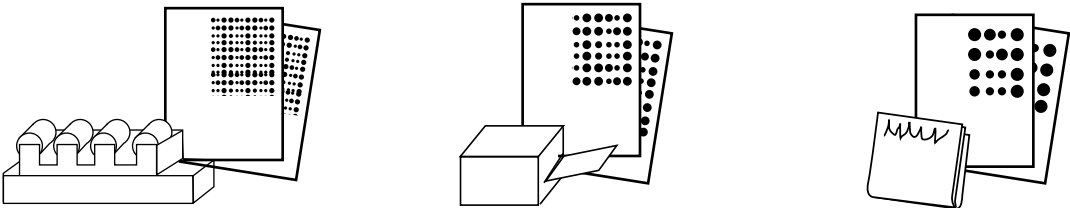
Most images are initially captured with devices... ...that use picture elements (pixels).

Figure out how much is enough information by working backwards.

1ST— Decide what print media your _____ will be produced on.



2ND— By knowing the print media you can determine the **Lines Per Inch** (_____)



3RD— For each *Line Per Inch* the final image prints at you need 2 *Pixels Per Inch* of info as image is captured.
